***A Resolution to Recommend Investigation of the Actions & Qualifications of Tennis Coach
Nancy Rahn***

Whereas, the Undergraduate Student Government is here to advocate for all students,

Whereas, much doubt and publicity is associated with Coach Rahn and the Department of Athletics and their relationship with the Tennis team

Whereas, the lack in confidence by members of the Tennis Team is severe enough to merit an investigation and temporary relief of her coaching duties,

Whereas, the lack of veteran tennis players on the Case Tennis team could harm Case Western Reserve University's reputation in the University Athletic Association (UAA),

Be it resolved by the Undergraduate Student Government, acting in full session:

- I. We recommend that Vice President for Student Affairs Glenn Nicholls, or his designee from the Office of Student Affairs, fully investigate the matters alleged by the tennis team, including but not limited to the allegations of resume fraud.
- II. We recommend Coach Nancy Rahn be temporarily relieved of her coaching duties in the Department of Athletics.
- III. We recommend a temporary coach be appointed so as to not adversely affect the Case Tennis program during these vital months of training for their spring season.
- IV. Tennis players who resigned from the team should be allowed to return to the team if they so choose, without sanction.
- V. Charge the USG Committee on Student Life and President Adam Rupe to monitor the Department of Athletics and Varsity Sports Program for any other problems associated with staffing, coaching, or athlete treatment.



- VI. That the tenets of this resolution take effect immediately upon passage in the General Assembly, and be relayed to Vice President for Student Affairs Glenn Nicholls & Athletic Director Dave Diles.
