A Resolution to Review and Enforce the University Posting Policy

Whereas, there is a Case Western Reserve University posting policy that groups and individuals are expected to follow,

Whereas, it has become apparent that groups and individuals are not following Case Western Reserve University posting policy,

Whereas, groups and individuals are instead posting wherever with a complete disregard for the posting policy,

Whereas, old flyers are not being removed by university staff,

Whereas, the excess of flyers are unsightly, overwhelming, and environmentally unfriendly,

Whereas, continuing to not enforce the Case Western Reserve posting policy is leading to more posting violations;

Be it resolved by the Undergraduate Student Government, acting in full session:

- I. That Case Western Reserve University publicizes and enforces the posting policy.
- II. That posting violations should be removed and violators should be reprimanded or fined.
- III. That all student groups be notified of the official posting policy and be notified of any changes in a timely manner.
