A Resolution to Recommend the Lighting of the “Spirit Wall” at Night

Whereas, the “Spirit Wall” located at the north end of Thwing Center is an effective and meaningful way for students to publicize their events,

Whereas, the current guidelines state that the wall should only be painted from the hours of midnight to 6:00 am,

Whereas, the current wall is susceptible to and frequently vandalized with spray paint graffiti, thus defacing the paintings for student organization events,

Whereas, a lighted “Spirit Wall” would allow for students to view event postings at all hours of the day and discourage vandalism,

Whereas, it is the job and duty of the Undergraduate Student Government and Case Western Reserve University to protect student safety when painting the wall and the integrity of those items painted on the wall by students;

Be it resolved by the Undergraduate Student Government, acting in full session:

- I. Recommends lighting should be installed over winter break to adequately light the “Spirit Wall” in a manner similar to billboards during times when other structures and pathways are lit on campus.
